



RECIPE

SCENTED BATH CRAYONS

These crayons are so much fun to play with, your children will be begging to take their baths!

Recipe makes 15 bath crayons.

What You Need:

INGREDIENTS:

- [SLS FREE GLYCERIN MELT AND POUR SOAP](#)
- [CRAYONS MOLD MARKET MOLD](#)
- [NATURES GARDEN OATMEAL MILK-N-HONEY FRAGRANCE OIL](#)
- [NATURES GARDEN BEDTIME BATH TYPE FRAGRANCE OIL](#)
- [NATURES GARDEN CHAMOMILE FRAGRANCE OIL](#)
- [NATURES GARDEN FUN SOAP COLORANT \(VARIETY\)](#)

OTHER EQUIPMENT:

- CUTTING BOARD
- STAINLESS STEEL MEASURING SPOONS
- MICROWAVE SAFE GLASS CONTAINER
- LARGE KNIFE
- SPRAY BOTTLE FILLED WITH RUBBING ALCOHOL
- SEVERAL GLASS BOWLS- ONE FOR EACH COLOR USED





Directions:

1. Cut your soap base along the perforation. Each crayon will use 2-3 cubes. For this recipe we are making 15 crayons.
2. Melt 13 cubes of SLS Free Glycerin Melt and Pour Soap Base in the microwave. Heat the base for 30 seconds at a time until it is completely melted.
3. Set out 5 glass bowls. Add 20 drops of Fun Soap Colorant to each bowl.
4. Remove soap from microwave and add one teaspoon of Oatmeal Milk-n-Honey fragrance oil. Stir.
5. Quickly pour equal amounts of scented soap into each of the glass bowls. Stir.
6. Pour each bowl into one cavity of the crayon mold. If soap hardens before you can pour it, just put the glass bowl back into the microwave for 10 seconds at a time until completely melted. If you notice any air bubbles, spray them with the rubbing alcohol.
7. Repeat this process again using one teaspoon of Bedtime Bath Type fragrance oil.
8. Repeat this process again using one teaspoon of Chamomile Fragrance oil.
9. Allow to cool at room temp, or refrigerate to help soap release from the mold.
10. Remove the soap from the mold.

Note: These soap crayons were tested by little kids, and they loved them! They wrote on the shower walls, and clean up was easy. The neon colors did not show up as well as the other colors.
