ICE CANDLE

Embrace crazy effects by making some ice candles!



Recipe makes 1 pillar candle

What You Need:

INGREDIENTS:

You Will Need:

[One pound of Nature Garden Pillar of Bliss Wax](#)

[One ounce of Natures Garden Fragrance Oil](#)

[Natures Garden Spectrum Liquid Candle Dye](#)

[Natures Garden Pillar Mold 3 x 4 1/2](#)

[Thermometer](#)

[Pouring Pot](#)

[Spoiled wicking](#)

Sink

Crushed Ice





Directions:

1. Wick your mold as usual.
2. Melt one pound of Pillar of Bliss wax to 195 degrees, and add coloring. Drop melted wax temperature to 180 degrees and add 1 ounce of fragrance.
3. Fill your mold with crushed ice. You want the ice to be about $\frac{3}{4}$ in. Leave a little bit of space at the top to ensure the wax will completely cover the ice.
4. Pour the wax over the ice.
5. Allow the wax to cool and the ice to melt completely.
6. Once cooled turn the mold upside down over the sink and pour out the melted ice.
7. Gently, remove the candle from the mold. Please note it will be very fragile.
8. Trim your wick to $\frac{1}{4}$ in. Do not light the candle for approximately 5 days. You want to ensure that it is completely dry.
