ZEBRA PRINT SOAP

Take a walk on the wild side with these awesome zebra print soaps!



Recipe makes 9 slices of soap.

What You Need:

INGREDIENTS:

[NATURAL SHEA BUTTER MELT AND POUR SOAP BASE](#)

[BLACK MELT AND POUR SOAP BASE](#)

[SQUARE LOAF MOLD](#)

[NATURES GARDEN BITE ME FRAGRANCE OIL](#)

[NATURES GARDEN MITRE BOX](#)

[NATURES GARDEN CUTTER FOR MITRE BOX](#)

OTHER EQUIPMENT:

CUTTING BOARD

STAINLESS STEEL MEASURING SPOONS

MICROWAVE SAFE GLASS CONTAINER

LARGE KNIFE

SPRAY BOTTLE FILLED WITH RUBBING ALCOHOL





Directions:

1. Cut your soap base along the perforation. Each layer will use 4-6 cubes; depending on the stripes this can vary. For this recipe we have approximately 8 layers.
2. Melt 6 cubes of Shea Butter Melt and Pour Soap Base in the microwave. Heat the base for 30 seconds at a time until it is completely melted.
2. Add one teaspoon of Bite Me fragrance oil. Stir.
3. Pour the mixture into the mold. If you notice any air bubbles, spray them with the rubbing alcohol.
4. Allow this layer to form a skin. While you are waiting, prepare your next layer. This time use the Black Melt and Pour Soap Base. Prepare the same way you did the Shea Butter soap.
5. In order to create angles to the layers use something to prop the mold up slightly on one side.
6. Repeat this process until the mold is full. Allow to cool at room temp, or refrigerate to help soap release from the mold.
7. Remove the soap from the mold. Cut the soap using the mitre box and cutter.
