Lavender Luxury Cold Process Soap

Recipe makes approximately 4 pounds of soap.

Here's How It's Done : Directions

Total Recipe Weights:

517 grams Water

186 grams Lye

408 grams Olive Oil Pomace

408 grams Shea Butter

272 grams Coconut Oil 76

272 grams Palm Oil

84 grams Lavender Luxury Fragrance Oil

12 grams Deep Purple Fun Soap Colorant

24 grams Lavender Flowers Whole Select

24 grams Rose Petals Pink

Clean & Sanitize your work area and all of your packaging materials. It is suggested that you wear gloves, protective clothing, a face mask, safety glasses, and a hair net while preparing this recipe.

In a bowl, measure out and break up the rose petals. Next, add the lavender flowers. Stir then set aside.

Proceed with the normal soaping procedure. Once the soap batter is scented and blended, weigh out and remove 908 grams. Place this into a separate container and add 12 grams Deep Purple Fun Soap Colorant. Mix well. Once you are ready, take the purple colored soap batter and drop several spoonfuls into the uncolored batter bowl. Then, using a spatula, swirl directly in the bowl. Finally, pour all of the soap batter into the mold.

When all 4 loaf molds have been filled, sprinkle the herbs on top. Once all soap has been covered with herb topping, and gently patted down; allow the soap to set for 24 hours. Then, unmold.

When ready to cut, lay out a paper towel and carefully place the soap upside down. Note: Some herbs will fall off. However, cutting the soap from the bottom will prevent the herbs from streaking down the soap with each cut. Allow for cure.
