



Pinecone Christmas Ornament Recipe

Recipe makes six scented pinecone ornaments

Here's What You Need:
Ingredients

[Disposable Pipettes](#)
[Sleigh Ride Fragrance Oil](#)

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Glue
Foam Brush or Paint Brush
Wax paper
Small Glass Bowl
Twine
Pinecones
Plastic Easter Eggs
Glitter
Hot Glue Gun
Glue Sticks



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Step 1: First, lay down newspaper or wax paper. Preparing your work area will help protect your work station from the glue and fragrance oil. This also makes cleanup much easier.

Step 2: Start by preparing your glue. You will need about 1 ounce of glue. The amount might be more or less depending on the size of your pinecones and Easter eggs. Now, in your small bowl, mix 1 ounce of glue to 1-2 ml of Sleigh Ride Fragrance Oil and stir thoroughly.

Step 3: Once your scented glue is ready, brush your entire pinecone with glue. Then, roll them in glitter. While this will only cover the outer edges with glitter, the remaining glitter will dry clear and give your ornament a nice strong scent. Allow the pinecones to dry.

Step 4: While you are waiting, go ahead and prepare the Easter eggs. We will only be using the smaller halves of the eggs for this project. So, cover the smaller halves with unscented glue. Then, cover them with glitter. Allow these to dry as well.

Step 5: Once both the pinecones and Easter eggs have dried, we will use hot glue to keep the two parts together. Place hot glue around the inner perimeter of the Easter egg. Then, place the Easter egg over the bottom of the of the pinecone.

Step 6: Once the hot glue dries, place a piece of twine or ribbon around the tops of the pinecones.

Your scented pinecone ornaments are now ready to hang! Enjoy!
