



Pink Salt Bath Bomb

Recipe makes approximately 2 large bath bombs.

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Scale

Witch Hazel (in spray bottle)

2- Clear Round Acrylic Fillable Ornaments-

3" diameter each

Mixing Bowls

Stirring Spoon



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Total Recipe Weights:

- 132 grams Citric Acid
- 263 grams Baking Soda
- 68 grams Corn Starch
- 5 grams Bentonite Clay
- 30 grams Coconut Oil 76
- 30 grams Himalayan Pink Salt- Fine Ground
- 20 grams Himalayan Pink Salt- Course Ground
- 5 grams Fun Soap Colorant- Neon Pink
- 1 gram Che Bella Donna Fragrance Oil

This recipe is best prepared in non-humid climates. Prior to making this recipe, pour some of your witch hazel into your spray bottle in order to have this ready.

Step 1: Weigh out and mix 263 grams of Baking Soda, 68 grams of Corn Starch, 30 grams of Himalayan Pink Salt- Fine Ground, and 5 grams of Bentonite Clay in a mixing bowl. If there are any clumps, break them up with your hands.

Step 2: In a separate bowl mix 30 grams of Coconut Oil 76 (at room temperature), 1 gram of Che Bella Donna fragrance oil and 5 grams of Neon Pink Fun Soap Colorant. Use a spoon to mix these ingredients together. It will have a clumpy paste like consistency.

Step 3: Use a spatula to add the wet ingredients bowl to the dry ingredients bowl. Using your hands, incorporate well. You will want to ensure the colorant is throughout the entire mixture.

Step 4: Next, add 132 grams of citric acid to the bowl. Stir in to incorporate. Make sure to break up any clumps.

Step 5: Weigh out 20 grams of the Course Himalayan Pink Salt. Using your fingers, sprinkle the salt into one half of each fillable ornament.

Step 6: Then, press the mixture into both halves of the mold, press down firmly. Now, spritz both halves of the ornaments with witch hazel. Next, attach the ornament halves together. Allow to set up.

Step 7: Once they have hardened, carefully remove the bath bombs from the mold.

Your Pink Salt Bath Bombs are now ready for use. Enjoy!

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
