



Sandalwood Candle Recipe

Recipe makes one candle.

Here's What You Need:
Ingredients

[Joy Wax](#)
[Pillar of Bliss Wax](#)
[Sandalwood Fragrance Oil](#)
[Chocolate Color Block](#)
[Pink Color Block](#)
[CD Candle Wicks \(100 wicks\)](#)
[POURING POT](#)
[THERMOMETER](#)
[Silicone 4 Loaf Mold](#)

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

16 oz. Glass Apothecary Jar
Scale
Mixing Spoons
Knife
Hot Glue Gun and Stick
Pot (For Double Boiler)



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Step 1: First, weigh out 120 grams of Pillar of Bliss Candle Wax. Then, using a double boiler, melt the candle wax.

Step 2: When the Pillar of Bliss Wax has melted, you will need to add about three grams of a chocolate color block to create a chocolate color. Stir to incorporate the colorant. To ensure that you have the correct color, you can test your color by using a spoon to place a small amount of wax on a white paper plate. Once this wax sets up, you can see the true color of the wax. If needed, add more of the color block.

Step 3: Once your candle wax is colored, add 12 grams of Natures Garden Sandalwood fragrance oil. Again, stir the wax to blend the ingredients.

Step 4: Next, pour some of the melted wax into each cavity of the 4-loaf silicone mold.

Step 5: Once the wax has setup, remove it from the mold. Then, use a knife to cut the wax into square pieces. When you are finished they will look like chocolates. Set these pieces aside, for now.

Step 6: Now, weigh out and melt 300 grams of the Joy Wax using a double boiler.

Step 7: Once melted, add a very small amount of a pink color block. Once again, you will need less than a gram. Stir to blend the colorant with the candle wax.

Step 8: You will need to add 30 grams of the Sandalwood Fragrance Oil. Stir to incorporate the Sandalwood fragrance oil.

Step 9: Next, add your wicks to the jar, adhering them with hot glue. You want to make sure that your wick tabs are centered and evenly placed in the jar.

Step 10: Pour the melted wax into the candle jar. Then, drop your chocolate colored cubes gently into the jar. Make sure you keep the wicks straight and centered as you are doing this.

Step 11: Allow your candle to fully setup before trimming the wicks and allowing the candle to cure.

Once cured, your Sandalwood Candle will be ready to burn. Enjoy!

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
