# Spider Venom Soap Jelly Recipe

*Recipe makes approximately 1- 8oz. Jar of soap jelly.*

Here's What You Need:  
Ingredients

[SLS FREE Glycerin Melt and Pour Soap](#)  
[Grape Fragrance Oil](#)  
[Da BOMB Soap Dye- BLUE 1oz.](#)  
[Da BOMB Soap Dye- RED 1oz.](#)  
[OPTIPHEN - Preservative](#)  
[8 oz. Clear PET JAR](#)  
[White Straight Smooth Lid 70/400](#)  
[THERMOMETER](#)  
[8 oz. Clear PET Bullet Bottles](#)  
[Black Fine Mist Sprayers 24/410](#)

## Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Scale  
Distilled Water  
Mixing Bowl  
Mixing Spoon  
Plastic Spiders (optional)  
Rubbing Alcohol



## Here's How It's Done : Directions

### **Total Recipe Weights:**

100 grams SLS Free Clear Melt and Pour Soap

153 grams Distilled Water

12 grams Grape Fragrance Oil

4 grams Optiphen

4 drops Da Bomb Soap Dye Red

2 drops Da Bomb Soap Dye Blue

Prep your work area by cleaning and sanitizing it.

**Step 1:** In a microwave safe container, melt 10 grams of the SLS Free Clear Melt and Pour Soap.

**Step 2:** Then, add 153 grams of warm distilled water.

**Step 3:** Now, when the temperature is between 120-140 degrees, add 4 grams of Optiphen. Mix well.

**Step 4:** Then, add 3 drops of Da Bomb Soap Dye- Red, 2 drops of Da Bomb Soap Dye- Blue and 12 grams of Grape fragrances oil. Stir.

**Step 5:** Pour the mixture into the 8 oz. Clear PET Jar. Spritz any air bubbles with alcohol.

**Step 6:** Allow the mixture to set up overnight or in the refrigerator for a few hours.

**Step 7:** Finally, decorate your jar with spider webs and spiders. This is of course optional.

Your Spider Venom Soap Jelly is now ready to use!

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
