



Valentine's Day Scented Rocks

Recipe makes approximately 1 cup of batter.

Ingredients

[Sinfully Hot Fragrance Oil](#)
[Da BOMB Soap Dye- RED 1oz.](#)
[Arrowroot Powder](#)
[Da BOMB Soap Dye- BLUE 1oz.](#)
[MICA- DIAMOND DUST Pigment 1oz](#)
[Dead Sea Salt High Minerals Fine Ground](#)
[Embed Mold - Medium Hearts](#)

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Flour
Water
Mixing Bowl
Mixing Spoon
Measuring Cups



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Total Recipe Amounts:

- 1/4 teaspoon Arrowroot Powder
- 1/4 cup dead sea salt (fine)
- 3/4 cup white flour + more if batter is sticky
- 1/3 cup boiling water
- 1 Tablespoon Sinfully Hot Fragrance Oil
- Da BOMB Soap Dye- RED (use the amount you desire)
- DaBomb Soap Dye- Blue (use the amount you desire)
- Diamond Dust Mica Pigment (use the amount you desire)

1. Mix 3/4 cup white flour, 1/4 cup dead sea salt, and 1/4 teaspoon arrowroot powder.
2. Boil water, and add 1/3 cup of boiling water to your dry ingredients that you mixed.
3. Add 1 Tablespoon of Sinfully Hot Fragrance Oil to your mixture and form a ball of dough.
4. Divide your dough into 2 balls.
5. Color 1 ball of dough a grey color by mixing generous amounts of both Blue and Red DaBomb Soap dyes. Knead dough.
6. Add 1 teaspoon of diamond dust mica pigment to the dough, and slightly mix in.
7. Form dough into small rocks.
8. Color the other ball of dough a red color by mixing generous amounts of Red DaBomb soap dye into the dough. Knead dough. Add more flour if your batter is sticky.
9. Place dough into heart shaped plastic molds to form hearts. Remove from mold carefully.
10. Allow all rocks and hearts to dry at room temp. Flip them over so that both sides receive enough air to dry completely.
