Emulsified Sugar Scrub Recipe

Recipe makes 5- 4 oz. containers

Ingredients

[OLIVE Oil- Pomace](#)

[COCOA BUTTER Golden Natural](#)

[SWEET ALMOND Oil- 16 oz.](#)

[SHEA BUTTER](#)

[VITAMIN E OIL \(Tocopherol T-50\) Natural](#)

[EMULSIFYING Wax NF- Traditional](#)

[WHITE BEESWAX Pastilles](#)

[Sugar Cookie Brulee Fragrance Oil](#)

[OPTIPHEN - Preservative](#)

[4 oz. Clear PET JAR](#)

[White Straight Lid Smooth 58/400](#)

[Disposable Pipettes](#)

White granulated sugar



Here's How It's Done : Directions

136 grams - Olive Oil
113 grams - Sweet Almond Oil
68 grams - Cocoa Butter
68 grams - Shea Butter
45grams - Emulsifying Wax
9 grams - Beeswax
9 grams - Sugar Cookie Brulee Fragrance Oil
5 grams - Optiphen preservative
5 grams Vitamin E Oil
For a Light Scrub - add 16 oz white sugar
For a Very Scrubby Scrub - add up to 32 oz white sugar

Clean & Sanitize your work area and all of your packaging materials. It is suggested that you wear gloves, protective clothing, and a hair net while preparing this recipe.

Weigh out olive oil, sweet almond oil, cocoa butter, shea butter, emulsifying wax, and beeswax. Melt in a double boiler until everything is completely melted.

Allow temperature to reach 120F and add optiphen preservative, vitamin E oil, and fragrance oil.

Place in the refrigerator to cool to around 80F.

Now Whip it with a hand mixer with whisk attachments or your Kitchen-Aid, whisk until it looks like pudding.

Next, add the sugar and whisk until well incorporated.

Pour into jars and let sit until hardened.
